<u>A 501(C)3 ORGANIZATION</u> 2023 Scholarship Application Cover Page Requirements & Instructions

<u>Eligibility</u>

- 1. Be age 19 years or younger.
- 2. Be a graduating senior, a graduate, or have obtained a GED from an accredited educational institution.
- 3. Be a U.S. Citizen or an eligible non-citizen.
- 4. Be a resident of the Homestead/South Dade area.
- 5. Have an <u>unweighted grade</u> point average of 2.5 or better.
- 6. Have completed community service <u>IN EXCESS</u> of the required minimum needed for graduation.
- 7. Be accepted or pending acceptance as a full-time undergraduate student in an accredited university, college, community college, vocational/technical school. If application is presented with pending acceptance then actual acceptance must be provided before scholarship funds will be disbursed.
- 8. Pursue a recognized course of study.
- The completed application (pages 1-4) and all additional information MUST be mailed to the above P.O. Box, or emailed to miadevane2@yahoo.com no later than March 31, 2023. If emailing, type in the subject: 2023 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FOR XXX (applicant's name).

Value of Scholarship

Each scholarship awarded will be in the amount of a minimum of \$500.00. Scholarships awarded are based on factors including but not limited to grade point average and community service. Scholarship monies will be paid directly to the educational institution.

Required Documents:

- 1. A completed application. Failure to submit a complete application may result in automatic disqualification. Applications received after the deadline will not be accepted.
- 2. Academic information, including grade point averages, test scores and other academic achievements certified by a school administrator. (Use page 4 of application)
- 3. Two Letters of Recommendation. At *least* one Letter of Recommendation from outside your school.
- 4. A personal statement, no more than 500 words, typed, addressing the importance of a COLLEGE OR VOCATIONAL/TECHNICAL EDUCATION and specifically your views regarding the importance of COMMUNITY SERVICE. IMPORTANT!!!
- 5. A copy of the acceptance letter from the educational institution you are planning to attend must be provided to obtain scholarship funds.
